“Go ye, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. And lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the earth.” (Matthew 20:19-20)



One of the vital areas of gospel presentation is missions. The Lord, in His last statement to His disciples, compelled them to go into every area of the world with the gospel message to win the lost, to baptize them into the church, and to make disciples of all who would listen and respond positively to the Holy Spirit's call to salvation. Southern Baptists have answered the call to missions for over 150 years with missionaries in almost every nation on the face of the earth. Today there are about 10,000 Southern Baptist missionaries serving with the North American Mission Board and the International Mission Board in 153 countries. Southern Baptists support their missionaries through giving to the Cooperative Program which is an organization within the Convention whereby all churches, regardless of size, can contribute to the support of Baptist work around the world. Through our giving to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering foreign missions are supported and through the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering we support North American (Home) missions. **Today, Trinity will host a missionary that will speak during the morning worship time with a report of work of which he is personally involved. At 5:30 p.m., we will attend a missions rally at FBC Statesboro where we will be able to meet and greet several missionaries and worship together with them.** Don't miss these opportunities to show support to those we have sent on mission. All of us cannot go but we can all pray and contribute to those who are called and willing to go on our behalf to tell the good news to all nations.



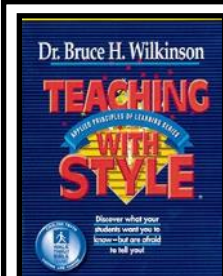

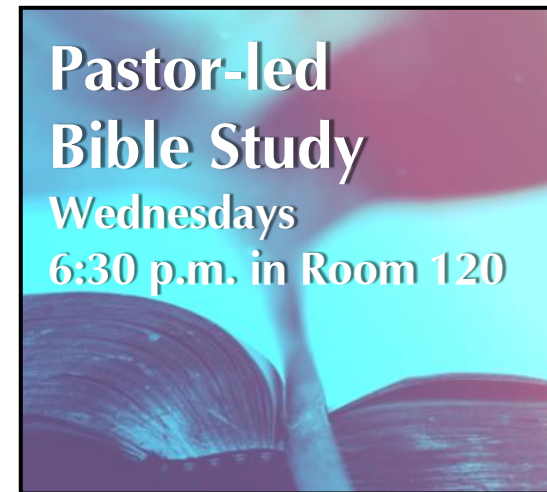

Church Library

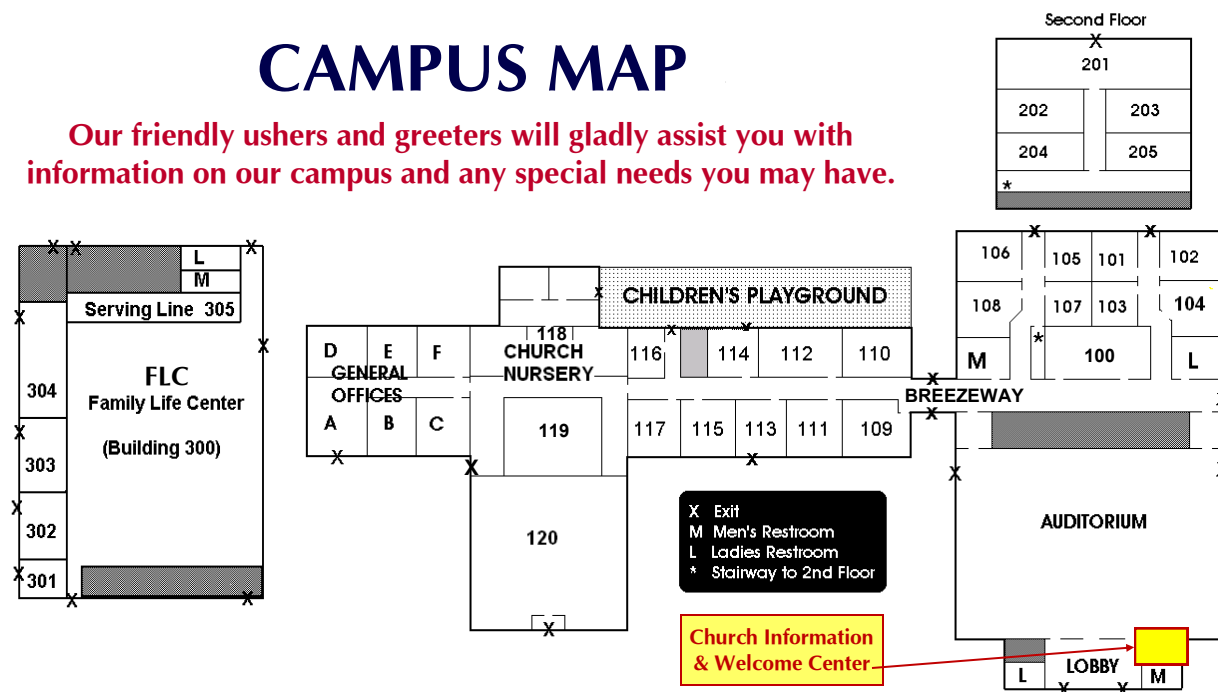
The church library is located in room 119 and is open during church office hours and when the church is open on Sundays and Wednesdays.
